LETTER FROM THE CHAIR AND EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Dear Citizens of Ohio,

As the Ohio Arts Council (OAC) begins its 45th year we want to recognize the extraordinary contributions the arts and culture have made to our state's economy, education and quality of life. Across Ohio the arts are helping to build healthier, more livable, more vital communities. We should be proud of what collectively has been accomplished to build the state—economically, educationally and culturally. Ohio is rich in a variety of cultural assets. This diversity comes from you—Ohio's artists, arts organizations, educators and citizens—and from this agency working every day to ensure fair and equitable distribution of public funds to help provide access to the arts for all.

While the biennium began with a financial upswing in 2007 when the Legislature and Governor Strickland provided an 11.1 percent increase to the OAC budget, the national recession delivered a major financial blow to the creative industries overall. Withstanding a 47 percent cut to the agency's budget by the end of the biennium, the OAC proved resilient in the face of this difficult funding environment and emerged more lean and efficient. The OAC has continued to serve a vital role in the state's recovery through its leadership, support of economic development and jobs in the creative industries, promoting academic excellence through the arts and 21st century education initiatives, building capacity within arts and cultural organizations in the state, and providing excellent constituent service.


The arts are a potent force in the economic life of communities statewide. The recent study by the Center for Regional Economic Development at Bowling Green State University confirms that the arts and creative industries have an impact on our state that few can match, supporting more than 230,000 jobs and contributing \$25 billion to Ohio's economy each year. During the OAC's statewide Listening Tour, we heard repeatedly that communities were creating economic activity based on their regional artistic assets and cultural traditions. From the Youngstown Federal Plaza Corridor revitalization to the restoration of the Pemberville Opera House, the arts are helping to improve the state's economic conditions through their role in community development and revitalization efforts.

Major cities and many smaller towns and communities across Ohio can talk with pride about their artists, arts and cultural institutions, and arts initiatives that have created jobs, generated tax revenues, stimulated consumer spending and unified communities. A modest investment in arts and cultural organizations brings a tremendous return statewide. In 2009, \$8.1 million in grants from the OAC to Ohio arts, cultural and community organizations and schools was matched at a rate of \$52:1 generating \$419,070,969 in additional funding. This support from corporations, foundations and municipalities was leveraged from public investment to create tangible benefits in communities. In Toledo, after years of facing economic challenges, the city is undergoing an amazing economic transformation thanks in part to the city's arts and cultural sector. Artomatic 419, a month long exhibition featuring hundreds of local artists in under utilized or vacant buildings in the city's urban core called attracted more than 5,000 citizens in its first year and owners of surrounding businesses reported increased activity and a direct financial benefit. Within two months of the completion of the first event, the entire 12,000 square feet of the building that served as the venue was occupied by tenants for the first time in four years.

The arts are the foundation of creative, innovative industry and the future of our country and our state hinges on our students' ability to use their imaginations and creativity to fuel innovation in all fields of study and all career paths. However, creative problem-solving individuals do not appear overnight. They

are the products of an education system that consistently affords its students an environment supportive of creativity and inquiry. Results from schools like The Cleveland School of the Arts (CSA) demonstrate that the arts-centered approach is working. In addition to improved graduation rates and test scores, students who have an arts-centered education are becoming an integral part of the 21st century workforce. One recent CSA graduate received a full four-year scholarship to study engineering at The Ohio State University, while another is an automobile designer for Ford Motor Company, evidence of a track record of academic excellence achieved through arts-centered learning that prepares these students for college and life.

The OAC and its grantees are powerful agents of change. As we formally bring to a close the 2008-2009 biennium, let this Biennial Report be a testament to the vital arts and cultural organizations and talented artists that make Ohio a great place to live, work and visit. The needs and aspirations of the citizens of Ohio will serve as our guide as we work together to ensure that the arts remain an essential element of Ohio's future prosperity and success.

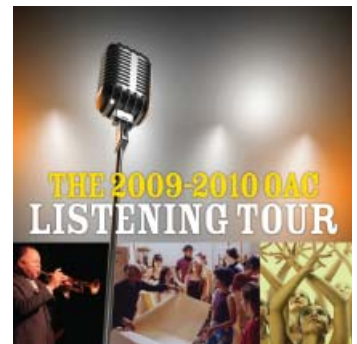
BIENNIUM HIGHLIGHTS

While the 2008-2009 biennium proved to be one of the most challenging the Ohio Arts Council (OAC) has seen in a long-time, the agency continued to find new and creative ways to support citizens and communities across the state. The OAC maintained its focus on leadership and excellence through the arts—fostering and encouraging the development of the arts across the state, preserving Ohio’s unique cultural heritage and strengthening Ohio communities economically, educationally and culturally. OAC grants ultimately touch the lives of millions through quality arts experiences in everything from theatre to dance, media to music, visual art to literature and all forms of folk and traditional art. Strong partnerships with state and national organizations help maximize state and federal funds and ensure access to the arts for all citizens.

Leadership and Excellence

Nationally the OAC continues to be a leader. In 2009, the National Endowment for the Arts awarded the OAC a \$1,023,600 grant and recognized the agency as a “national leader among the state arts agencies and in arts education” and as an agency “that works consistently at a high level and is known for its excellence.”

The OAC continually recognizes the importance of maintaining a personal relationship with constituents across Ohio. Between the fall of 2008 and early 2010 the OAC conducted 42 Listening Tour meetings in 14 Ohio communities—Archbold, Chillicothe, Cincinnati, Cleveland, Columbus, Coshocton, Dayton, East Liverpool, Kent, Mansfield, Marietta, Toledo, Wapakoneta and Youngstown. The Listening Tours illuminated the impressive accomplishments, driving aspirations and daily struggles of communities around the state. The meetings also provided an opportunity for Ohioans to share the vital role they believe the arts, creativity and imagination play in their community as they pursue a wide range of economic development strategies to retain and attract existing and new business, especially knowledge-based industries. Findings from the Listening Tour meetings will inform the development of the agency’s next strategic plan and the second State of the Arts Report (SOAR II).



The Ohio River Border Initiative (ORBI) is a partnership between the OAC and the West Virginia Commission on the Arts that serves arts organizations and artists in the 21 counties in Ohio and West Virginia that touch the river. Since 2006, ORBI has funded 59 projects through its annual grant program for a total of \$130,625. During this period, ORBI also funded 12 first-time applicants, demonstrating its success in generating new connections across the Ohio/West Virginia border. In 2008, ORBI also developed a new Accessibility Mini-Grant program in response to an identified lack of funds to support accessibility upgrades.

Each year the OAC supports and promotes Ohio’s extraordinary cultural assets through grant-making, promotion and marketing efforts. More than 600 organizations and artists receive grants each year that enable them to enrich their communities through their artistic endeavors and programming. Each year, the OAC reaches more than 650,000 Web site visitors through ArtsinOhio.com, the free statewide calendar of events. The wealth of Ohio’s cultural and artistic events helps generate tourism and generates income in communities across the state.

Ohio is home to a wealth of cultures and traditions. Through a variety of programs and services the OAC supports the folk and traditional arts in an effort to extend agency programs and services to underserved areas and build awareness for diverse cultures and traditions. In 2008 and 2009 the OAC conducted targeted field work to document traditions in Latino communities - one of the fastest growing populations in Ohio. In the spring of 2010, the OAC will publish a Web directory of Ohio Latino artists and arts organizations, profiles of significant Latino artists, and an essay on the state of Latino arts in Ohio.

Economic Development and Jobs

Grants awarded by the OAC help create and retain jobs and accelerate the economy. The OAC applied for and received over \$353,400 in federal funds through the NEA from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, leading to the creation of the Ohio Arts Jobs Preservation Grant program in April 2009. Together with funds from Arts Midwest the OAC awarded **\$395,000 in grants to 21 organizations in Ohio saving 25 jobs in the arts**. Through their work, the people in those jobs will touch the lives of more than 1.2 million Ohioans, many of them children.

In 2007 a grant awarded to Northwest Ohio arts and cultural nonprofits helped support a study by Bowling Green State University's Center for Regional Development. The statewide results of the Arts and Prosperity study released in April 2009, found that annually the creative industries contribute more than \$25 billion to Ohio's economy, support 231,000 jobs, and generate nearly \$3 billion in federal, state and local taxes.

The Quilt Barn Trails provide important economic development in many rural and underserved parts of Ohio. The first Quilt Barn Trail in the United States was started in Adams County, Ohio, in 2001 with support from the OAC. Since then, this ground-breaking community arts project has expanded to **21 Ohio counties and at least 26 other states across the nation and in Canada generating tourism and community pride**. Recognizing the importance of this grass roots arts process to community development, the OAC collaborated with Ohio University's Voinovich School of Leadership and Public Affairs in 2008 to publish the Quilt Barn Impact Study: Understanding the Value of the Ohio Quilt Barn Trail. Using a variety of qualitative research methods, the study was able to document the cultural, social and economic contributions quilt barn trails have made in Ohio communities. The publication also featured a map of each county's quilt barn trail that identified the location and name of each of the nearly 300 quilt barns in Ohio.

Support

Each year we track annual milestones. The specific numbers vary slightly from year to year, but the impact remains significant. In 2008 more than **17 million arts experiences were provided to Ohioans** through activities and events presented by OAC grantees and more than four million of those were children and young people. In 2009, \$8.1 million in grants to Ohio arts, cultural and community organizations and schools was matched at a rate of \$52:1 **generating \$419,070,969 in additional funds**. These grants also help Ohioans in need, particularly in the hard hit rural areas. Each year in the biennium, more than \$250,000 went to arts, cultural and community organizations, and schools across the 32 county Appalachian region of Ohio.

Education

The OAC is committed to supporting comprehensive arts education programs for children and youth. The OAC continues its strong partnership with the Ohio Department of Education (ODE), a collaboration that has brought recognition to Ohio as a national leader in the field of arts education and resulted in the award of hundreds of thousands of dollars in federal grants. Annually OAC arts education grants support arts programs for nearly 110,000 young people and 165,000 individuals through life-long learning programs.

Poetry Out Loud is a national recitation contest created by the National Endowment for the Arts and the Poetry Foundation and presented in Ohio by the Ohio Arts Council in partnership with the Ohioana Library and the Thurber House. In the 2008, for the first time, Ohio's Poetry Out Loud was offered on a statewide basis and more than 4,000 students from 32 high schools participated. Nearly 70 schools received program materials and teachers from across Ohio attended a training workshop in Columbus to learn how to implement the program in their classrooms. Student school champions also attended workshop to help them prepare for the State Finals. First Lady Frances Strickland attended the state finals and welcomed the students, family members and guests. Twenty-three school champions competed in the state final. Rachel Chandler, the Ohio winner, was among the top eight contestants in her semi-final round at the National Competition in Washington, D.C. and her picture appeared in the USA Today newspaper. **In 2009, 27 school**

champions competed in the Ohio Poetry Out Loud State Finals and more than 5,000 students from 35 high schools from Ohio took part. Workshops were once again offered to teachers and students. Upper Arlington High School student Mido Aly was selected as first place winner and traveled to Washington, D.C. where he was among the top five contestants in the National Finals event hosted by Scott Simon of National Public Radio.

The OAC participated in the formation of the **Committee for Arts and Innovative Thinking (CAIT)**, a statewide arts advisory group sponsored by ODE. The purpose of the committee is to promote and advance the arts in the lives of all Ohio students through strategic actions, communications and policy recommendations. Through CAIT, OAC and ODE are developing a coordinated approach to expanding opportunities and making the arts basic to preK-12 education.

Capacity Building and Knowledge

The OAC recognized the need for a comprehensive planning guide for arts professionals and others working in schools and nonprofit organizations at the state and local levels. This motivated the OAC to develop *Focusing the Light: the Art and Practice of Planning*. Focusing the Light presents a fundamental management strategy that reflects what has been learned over two decades of practice at the federal, state, and local levels into a rich and accessible repository. The project includes a seven-volume set of booklets as well as related online resources including electronic copies of the booklets, worksheets and other tools. The seven-volume series provides those who work in the arts and nonprofits with strategies, tips, and techniques for successful project planning, advocacy and evaluation. It illustrates what is needed to create significant works for communities, secure funding for these initiatives, and evaluate the results.



OAC staff continued to hear from grantees about meaningful, positive experiences as a result of OAC funding. In 2009 the OAC released a new series of success stories from all over Ohio where the arts have been a “part of the solution” and OAC support has been a key ingredient. *The Arts: Part of the Solution* stories focus on a number of important public benefits to Ohio such as development of creativity and imagination, economic development and revitalization, academic excellence through the arts, cultural participation and community cohesion.

Constituent Service

Grant-making is one of the most important functions of the OAC and agency staff work hard to provide constituents the highest level of service. Each year the OAC conducts a constituent satisfaction survey and every year constituents indicate a very high level of satisfaction in service from the OAC. Respondents also comment frequently on the OAC staff’s positive attitude, professionalism and knowledge of their field.

The OAC staff fully understands that applying for a grant can be a challenging process for any organization and therefore regularly reviews its grant *Guidelines* and applications. Between January and October of 2008, cross-departmental teams successfully revised and realigned the OAC grant-making *Guidelines* in several of the agency’s most critical program areas. The new *Guidelines* are designed to be easier for applicants and panelists to use and understand, reflect the most current agency thinking on cultural participation and public value, and show clear alignment between each program’s purpose statement, scoring criteria and application questions. The Online Grant Application (OLGA) was introduced in 2006 and continues to assist the agency as it strives to maximize use of electronic communications to reach constituents and save costs.

Since 2006, the OAC expanded its partnership with VSA arts of Ohio (VSAO), resulting in two workshops for artists with disabilities funded by the NEA as well as the development of a Career Workbook for artists with disabilities and the agencies that serve them. Other accomplishments included the development of a database of artists with disabilities and the resources available to them, and convening an artists with disabilities advisory group. In 2007, VSAO created an Artist Services Coordinator position with funding from

the OAC Capacity Building program; Derek Mortland, 2009 Governor's Awards for the Arts in Ohio winner, serves in this capacity, providing services to both VSAO and OAC.

Working with Ann Gazelle, an Ohio artist who is blind, the OAC **successfully updated its Web site in 2008 to be as accessible as possible to people with disabilities**. Although maintaining its accessibility is of course an ongoing process, today the site meets the requirements of the World Wide Web Consortium (W3C) (Level AA) Bobby and Section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act, as well as the Workforce Investment Act of 1998.

A staple in the central Ohio community and Ohio Arts Council history, the **OAC's Riffe Gallery celebrated its 20th anniversary** in March 2009. Established as a place for the citizens of Ohio to share, join and be part of the arts, the Riffe Gallery has presented 81 main gallery exhibitions and seven lobby exhibitions since its inception. Seventeen of the 81 exhibitions toured internationally, regionally or in-state.

The above examples provide only a snapshot of the OAC's accomplishments during the 2008-2009 biennium. The OAC looks forward to continuing this fundamental work in partnership with its constituents and the citizens of Ohio throughout the coming biennium.

About This Report

About the Ohio Arts Council

The OAC was created in 1965 to foster and encourage the development of the arts and the preservation of Ohio's cultural heritage. With funds from the Ohio Legislature and the National Endowment for the Arts, the OAC provides financial assistance to artists, arts organizations, schools and nonprofit organizations that provide arts programming for their communities. This is accomplished in two primary methods; first, through various grant funding programs to arts and cultural organizations and artists that make arts activities available to a broad segment of Ohio's public; and secondly, by providing services that help to enhance the growth of the arts. There are a total of seven different grant programs and a variety of additional programs operated by the OAC.



The OAC listens to the concerns of the citizens of Ohio through a variety of communication methods—from traditional to electronic—to ensure that the needs and priorities of the people of Ohio are addressed through the programs and services of the OAC. Through the information gathered from citizens, the OAC is able to continually nourish the economic, educational and cultural development of the state.

The executive director and OAC staff assist artists and arts and cultural organizations and schools by guiding them through the application process and by working with panel consultants to arrive at the funding recommendations presented to the OAC Board.

The OAC Board is composed of 15 voting members appointed by the governor and four non-voting members, two each from the Ohio Senate and House of Representatives. The OAC Board is responsible for final approval of funding requests. All OAC Board meetings are open to the public.

About our Partners

The **National Endowment for the Arts (NEA)** is the largest annual funder of arts in the U.S. An independent federal agency, the NEA is the official arts organization of the U.S. government. Created by Congress, it became an independent agency of the federal government on September 29, 1965. The NEA is a public agency dedicated to supporting excellence in the arts, both new and established; bringing the arts to all Americans; and providing leadership in arts education.

Arts Midwest connects the arts to audiences throughout a nine-state region of the Midwest providing meaningful arts opportunities, sharing creativity, knowledge, and understanding across boundaries. Member states include Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Michigan, Minnesota, North Dakota, Ohio, South Dakota and Wisconsin. One of the six nonprofit regional arts organizations in the United States, Arts Midwest's history spans more than 25 years. Arts Midwest reaches close to a million people annually by initiating cultural programs including performances by high-quality theater, dance and music ensembles; educational arts activities, visual arts exhibitions; and conferences.

Ohio Citizens for the Arts (OCA) is a statewide, nonprofit, grass-roots, membership organization working to increase public support for the arts in Ohio. Incorporated in 1976, OCA now represents all geographic areas of the state and all arts disciplines. It continues to work for increased funding for the arts in Ohio and increased public awareness of the arts by informing local citizens of the needs of the arts in Ohio; promoting citizens and arts organizational involvement in the statewide arts advocacy network; contacting Ohio's legislators and explaining issues that are important to the arts locally and statewide; bringing arts-related issues to the attention of the local media; and promoting greater support of the arts and arts advocacy efforts in business and industry. Throughout the state, OCA enables effective advocacy for funding of the Ohio Arts Council and the National Endowment for the Arts.

Celebration of Creativity: OAC Fellowships 1980-2005

July 26 - October 7, 2007

Featuring 18 Ohio artists from communities throughout the state, *Celebration of Creativity* brought together a diverse range of work that honored 25 years of Ohio Arts Council support to individual artists. Curators Dennis Harrington, Kay Koeninger and Kitty McManus Zurko assembled a collection of pieces from artists who received one or more OAC Fellowships since 1980. The result was a stunning exhibition that showcases and celebrates the wealth of creative, professional artists living and working in Ohio.



New Horizons: Rewards of Time and Place

November 8, 2007 - January 6, 2008

New Horizons featured work by 11 Ohio artists who participated in the Ohio Arts Council's domestic residencies program within the last 10 years. The result was artwork that reflects the tangible rewards artists gain from experiencing a new horizon.

Connections II: Ohio Artists Abroad

January 24 - April 6, 2008

Connections II featured artwork by 14 artists who participated in the Ohio Arts Council Individual Creativity international residencies program, which has long been recognized as a leader in international cultural arts exchanges among state arts agencies. Over the years the OAC has developed global partnerships, including residencies, with several countries. The artists in *Connections II* took part in opportunities established in Germany, Poland and the Czech Republic. These artists immersed themselves in their host communities and acted as cultural ambassadors for Ohio.



Kleibacker: New York Designer to Ohio Curator

May 8- July 6, 2008

Charles Kleibacker and the exhibitions of haute couture and ready-to-wear clothing that he has organized have been a consistent and welcome presence in the Columbus arts community for more than 20 years. During a time when developments in clothing design have often been in the forefront of culture and when fashion exhibitions have drawn crowds to the Metropolitan Museum of Art and other venues internationally, Kleibacker introduced fashion exhibitions to Columbus. Kleibacker helped make historical and contemporary clothing part of what audiences value seeing, and even expect to see, in arts institutions.

Midwestern Visions of Impressionism: 1890 - 1930

July 31 - October 18, 2008

Midwestern Visions of Impressionism: 1890 - 1930 took a fresh look at the American Impressionism movement through the paintings of 31 artists born or raised in the Midwest and working between 1890 and 1930. In addition to bringing attention to the often overlooked talent of Ohio, Illinois and Indiana; *Midwestern Visions of Impressionism* explored where these artists fit within the larger context of American Impressionism and how their regions informed their painting.





The Ohio Watercolor Society: 31st Annual Juried Exhibition 2008

November 6, 2008 - January 11, 2009

The Ohio Watercolor Society: 31st Annual Juried Exhibition featured 67 original paintings selected by, Juror Alvaro Castagnet, an artist and teacher from Uruguay. When choosing work for this exhibition, he looked for paintings that developed an instant reaction in him and stood out for a reason beyond the image alone.

Visual Dialogues

January 29 - April 12, 2009

Visual Dialogues represented artwork produced during an exchange between 11 German and Ohio artists who shared the distinctive experience of participating in printmaking residencies at Zygote Press in Cleveland and Grafikwerkstatt in Dresden, Germany. The Ohio Arts Council hosted the German artists in Cleveland and the City of Dresden sponsored the Ohio artists in Dresden.



New Narratives: Paintings by Ohio Artists

May 7 - July 12, 2009

New Narratives: Paintings by Ohio Artists explored the various themes and styles of narrative painting currently being made by 12 Ohio artists ranging from traditional figurative compositions to others using signs and symbols.
